DOUBLE YOUR GIFT

Many employers support employee giving via matching gift programs. You can double or even triple your gift to Legal Services! Please contact your employer's Human Resources Office for details.

NAMING OPPORTUNITIES

Leadership gifts have rewards beyond helping sustain the long term efforts of those providing legal assistance on behalf of those in need.

Named Endowment (\$10,000 min.): Donors will be encouraged to support LSNF through the 30th Anniversary Civil Legal Assistance Fund. Donors may endow either an area of service (Children's Advocacy, Consumer and Disaster, Domestic Violence, Family, Elders, General Services, Housing and Homelessness, Rural Outreach, Public Benefits, etc.) or geographic region of work (Fort Walton Beach, Panama City, Pensacola, Quincy, Tallahassee, etc) in the name or memory of someone or themselves. A commitment to complete the pledge within five years must be made before the endowment is named. Gifts can either be made in one lump sum, pro rated over 3-5 years or established as an irrevocable clause in a planned giving document.

Building Naming (\$5,000 to \$1 million): This gift level is not reflective of the total cost of a building, but rather represents a significant commitment. This category includes the naming of existing buildings such as our main office and branch offices and individual offices within each office (e.g. conference rooms, attorney offices, department offices, etc.) A commitment to complete the pledge within five years must be made before the building or associated office is named. Gifts can either be made in one lump sum, pro rated over 3-5 years or established as an irrevocable clause in a planned giving document. This is a very popular giving opportunity and a current list of available buildings and offices is located on the Internet at <http://lsnf.org/endowment/naming.htm>.

Endowed Attorney Position

A minimum outright commitment of \$1 million is required to fund a named attorney position to supplement an existing attorney position in a designated program area. A commitment to complete the pledge within five years must be made before the position is named. Gifts can either be made in one lump sum, pro rated over 3-5 years or established as an irrevocable clause in a planned giving document. The most distinguished and important gift that may have the greatest impact on the lives of children and families in perpetuity.
