## New or Expanding Projects

### (Direct Case Referrals in Family, Bankruptcy, and Property Law)

Volunteer attorneys are needed to handle cases for LSNF in family, bankruptcy and property law. If you have little experience and big interest in any of these areas or in other civil legal matters, we can assist you in all facets of your case handling. Secretarial support is available for government attorneys or those in private practice with little or no support services. As with all programs and projects using volunteer attorneys to provide legal assistance, malpractice coverage is provided.

### (Homeless Legal Advice Clinic)

Anyone interested in teaming up with another attorney to provide advice in a legal clinic setting at the Tallahassee homeless shelter one or two months per year is encouraged to inquire about this opportunity. It makes our job a little easier if you can recruit a colleague to assist. The second and fourth week of the month are available for assignments.

### (Evening Night Clinic)

Seventeen times a year ten to twenty clients are scheduled for an evening legal clinic at the offices of Legal Services from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m. (usually on the second and fourth Thursday of each month). Attorneys interested in helping LSNF with intake, providing legal advice, and/or handling the cases of interviewees need to contact us. We want to get more attorneys to handle the cases after the client interview; however, you need not take a case. A LSNF staff attorney is available at the clinic for any assistance. Full secretarial support is available for anyone taking a case.

### (Small Claims Advice Clinic)

Every other month at 7:30 p.m. on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday, LSNF hosts a small claims advice clinic led by a volunteer attorney at the Traffic Court on Thomasville Rd. in Tallahassee. Volunteer attorneys are needed to provide advice on how to file small claims actions to individuals participating in the clinic. No experience necessary.
